Report Notes & Data Qualifiers

The crime and offence data contained within this report is drawn from the PRIME records management system which captures occurrences that are either reported to or discovered by police. Counts represent the total number of police files, not the total number victims or items stolen. The data includes all crime types (i.e., not just the most serious) with a primary investigative unit of Surrey Police Service or RCMP Provincial Operations Support Unit. Date information in this report reflects the file "reported date". Location information reflects the Surrey police district in which the incident occurred, with category totals including files for which occurrence location information was not available.

On 2024-11-29, Surrey Police Service became the police of jurisdiction for the City of Surrey; from this date, Surrey policing statistics combine data from the Surrey Police Service and the Surrey RCMP/Surrey Provincial Operations Support Unit. Data should be interpreted with caution due to different organizational policies and data protocols between agencies. As PRIME is a "real-time" database, the information in this report is preliminary incident data and may not represent statistics submitted to the Canadian Center for Justice Statistics; the data is subject to change for a variety of reasons, including late reporting, the stage of an investigation, and reclassification due to changes in circumstances.

Category	Details
Homicide	Homicide data is provided by IHIT, based on their investigational files.
Shots Fired	Defined as a confirmed, deliberate discharge of a firearm, excluding police involved incidents, accidental firearm discharge, hunting/recreational firearm use in permissible areas, and suicide. Files are identified via a crime analyst review of Surrey PRIME files.
Illicit Drug Overdose Deaths	Files are identified via a crime analyst review of Surrey PRIME files.
Mental Health Related Files	Includes files with PRIME Special Study Flag code "B" ("Mental Health Related"); excludes files with CCJS code "A" ("Unfounded").

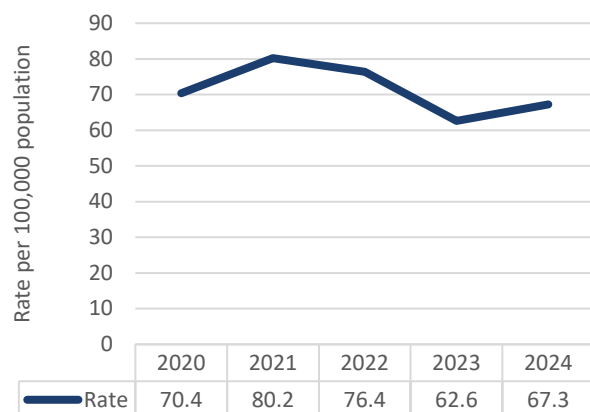

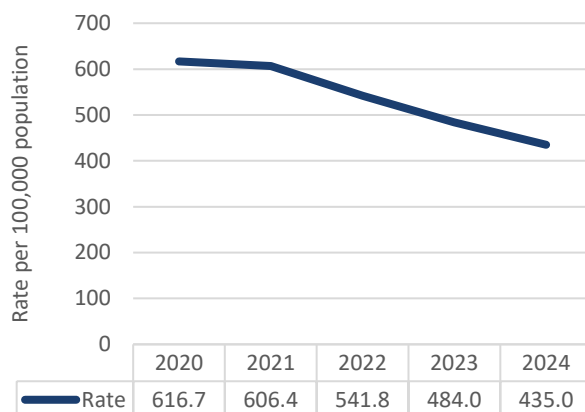

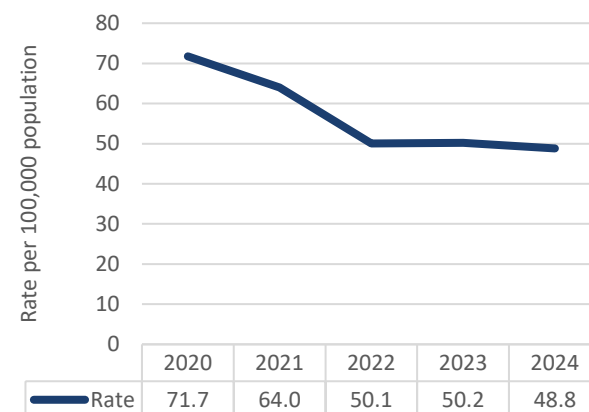
Sexual Assault/Interference Report Rate



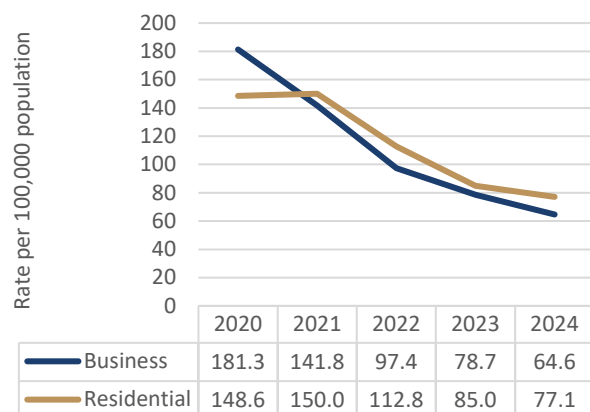
Assault Report Rate



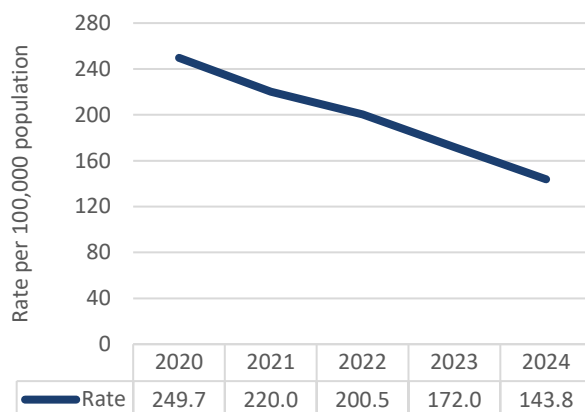
Robbery Report Rate



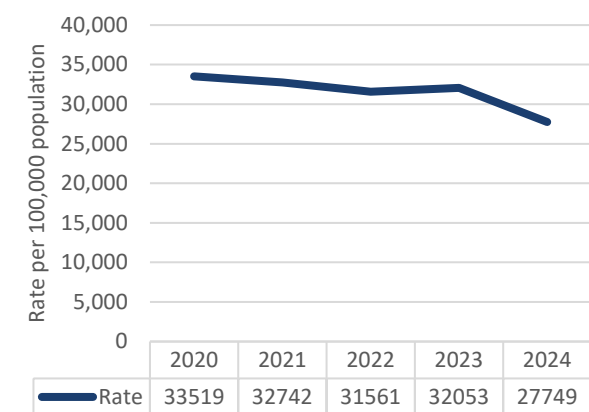
Break & Enter Report Rate
